**(Notification for State Schemes where beneficiaries are children)**

Whereas, the use of Aadhaar as an identity document for delivery of services or benefits or subsidies simplifies the Government delivery processes, brings in transparency and efficiency, and enable beneficiaries to get their entitlements directly in a convenient and seamless manner by obviating the need to produce multiple documents to prove one's identity;

And whereas, the Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training, Punjab (hereinafter referred to as the Department) is administering the Fee waiver Scheme upto a maximum of 5% (as per the AICTE approval process handbook and state government admission notifications issued from time to time) of the approved sanctioned intake per course are filled up from the candidates of economically weaker sections whose parents income is less than 8 lac per annum or as notified by the All India Council of Technical Education in their Approval Process Handbook (APH) of the concerned year, which is being implemented through the Department of Technical Education and Industrial training (herein after referred to as the implementing agency).

And whereas, under the Schemes, benefits of Tuition fee is given at the time of admission to the students by the Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training as per the extant Scheme guidelines.

And whereas, the aforesaid Schemes involves recurring expenditure incurred from the Consolidated Fund of State of Punjab (Tuition fee revenue).

Now therefore, in pursuance of section 7 of the Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016 (18 of 2016) (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), The Government of Punjab hereby notifies the following namely:

1.

- 1 A child desirous of availing the benefit under the Scheme shall hereby be required to furnish proof of possession of the Aadhaar number or undergo Aadhaar authentication.
- 2 Any child desirous of availing the benefit under the Scheme, who does not possess the Aadhaar number or, has not yet enrolled for Aadhaar, shall be required to make application for Aadhaar enrolment subject to the consent of his parents or guardians, before registering for the Scheme provided that he is entitled to obtain Aadhaar as per section 3 of the said Act and such children shall visit any Aadhaar enrolment centre (list available at the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) website [www.uidai.gov.in](http://www.uidai.gov.in)) to get enrolled for Aadhaar.
- 3 As per regulation 12 of the Aadhaar (Enrolment and Update) Regulations, 2016, the department through its Implementing Agency, is required to offer Aadhaar enrolment
